ORCID iD

What is it?

- **A unique identifier for researchers**
- **Originally for name disambiguation**
- **Easier to claim your work even if others share a similar name**

What are its uses?

- **Helps you manage your publications**
 - Helps ensure your scholarly profile reflects your actual output
 - Can be used to search databases for your research metrics
- **Link to other accounts for automated sharing between systems**
 - **E.g., publishers, Dimensions**
 - Can allow trusted parties to update your record
- **Required by some journals for manuscript submission**
 - <https://info.orcid.org/requiring-orcid-in-publications/>
- **Required by some funders**
 - <https://info.orcid.org/funders-open-letter/>
 - Also NIH research training, education, career development and fellowship awards
